Who is RSPO?

The Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil (RSPO) is a global, multi-stakeholder initiative on sustainable palm oil. Members of RSPO, and participants in its activities come from many different backgrounds, including plantation companies, processors and traders, consumer goods manufacturers and retailers of palm oil products, financial institutions, environmental NGOs and social NGOs, from many countries that produce or use palm oil. The RSPO vision is to "transform the markets by making sustainable palm oil the norm".

The RSPO was formed in 2004 in response to the urgent and pressing global call for sustainably produced palm oil, with the objective of promoting the growth and use of sustainable oil palm products through credible global standards and engagement of stakeholders.
